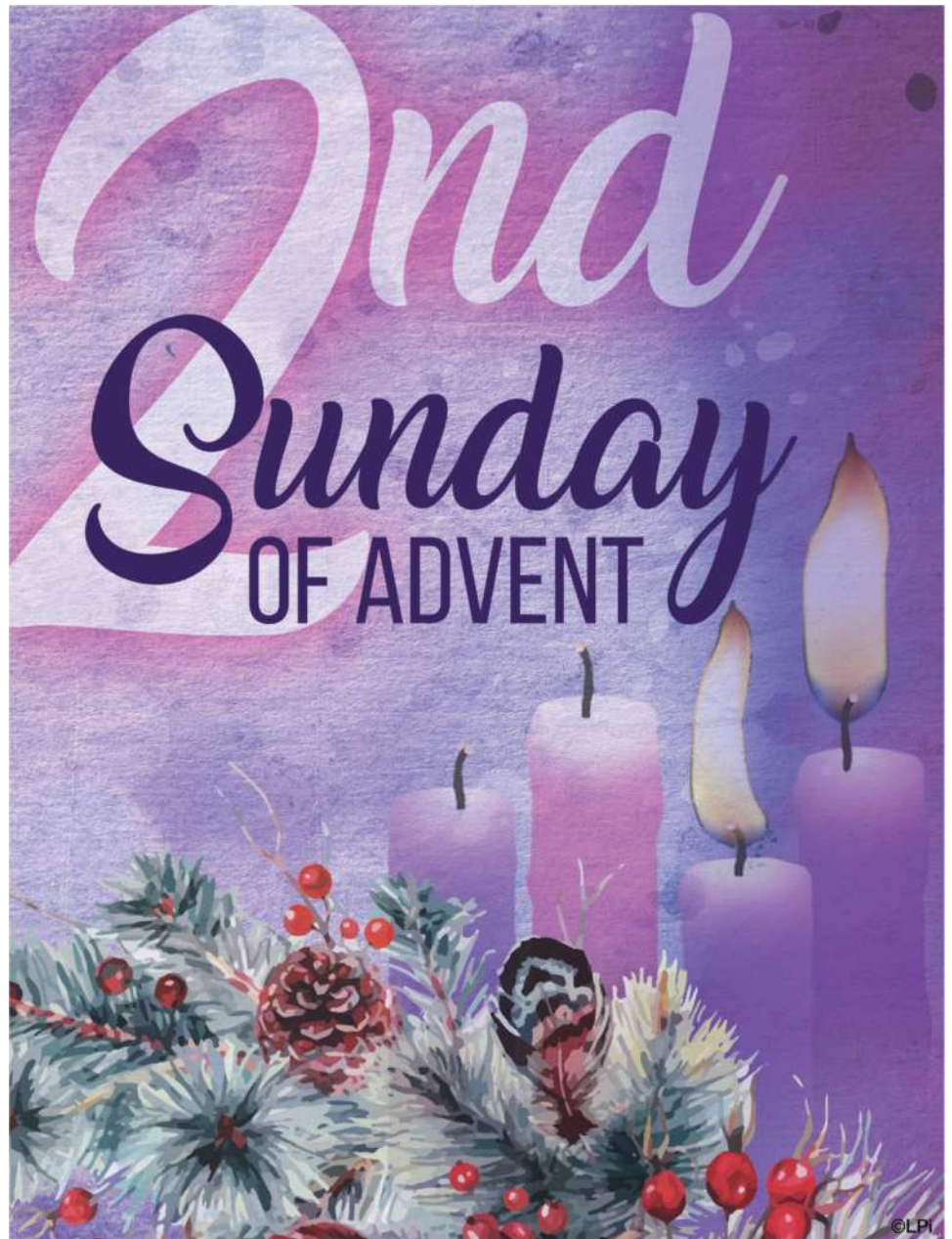

A WORD FROM Fr. Ryan

A priest friend of mine laughed as he told me about a conversation he recently had with a group of second graders. He said: “Advent is a time of getting ready... Who is coming?” The second graders all answered: “Santa Claus!”

We can laugh and smile at this because it’s funny. But it’s also an indictment of what most of our culture thinks of at Christmas. A jolly guy, in a red suit, squeezes himself down a chimney and brings toys. And because Santa Claus gives gifts, we all exchange gifts. Reindeer pull his big sled, and one of them has a shiny red nose that doubles as a searchlight in the event of a storm. It’s a fun story. But let’s not lose focus of what’s really worth celebrating as we prepare for Christmas.

In the midst of our preparations, let’s give prominence in our homes to a little plastic baby in a quaint manger scene. That little baby of course is watched over by His mother and her betrothed, an honorable man named Joseph.

This Christmas, we’ll shop, send cards, decorate our homes and get ready for family time because family time together is what Christmas is all about.

But let’s never lose sight of what Christmas is truly about: in that little town of Bethlehem, God was born. That Child Jesus came to save us from our sins. That Child, too weak to lift His own head, is also Mighty God and Prince of Peace. This child was born to die. His name, Jesus, means Savior.

He was born in an obscure village and in humble circumstances. He would write no books. He would only live publicly for three brief years. And still, no person in human history has left such an indelible mark as this Man. This Child in Bethlehem makes the difference between a life of quiet desperation and a life of meaning and purpose.

By His own will, God Himself became dependent on Mary, His mother. God needed Mary to pick Him up and carry Him where He must go. As a child, God Himself was absolutely helpless. He could go nowhere but where Mary chose to take Him. He was so vulnerable that Mary’s breathing was His breath, His heartbeat relied solely on the beating of her own heart.

Today, Jesus Christ is dependent upon us and He places great trust in us. During this time of Advent we must carry Him in our hearts to wherever He wants to go. And there are many places to which He may never go unless we take Him.



With that in mind, let’s pick up our Lord and bring Him to Church. Literally. Next weekend, we will begin a new tradition at St. Christina — **Bambinelli Sunday**. This wonderful tradition began during the papacy of Pope St. John Paul II. It is celebrated on *Gaudete Sunday*, the third Sunday of Advent, when the children of Rome and their families fill St. Peter’s Square for the blessing of the “little baby Jesus” from their nativity scenes at home.

Literally, bring Jesus with you to Mass next week! At each of our Sunday Masses we will bless your *bambinelli* — your little nativity scene Jesus. This promises to be a fun and prayerful way to prepare for Jesus’ birth at Christmas!

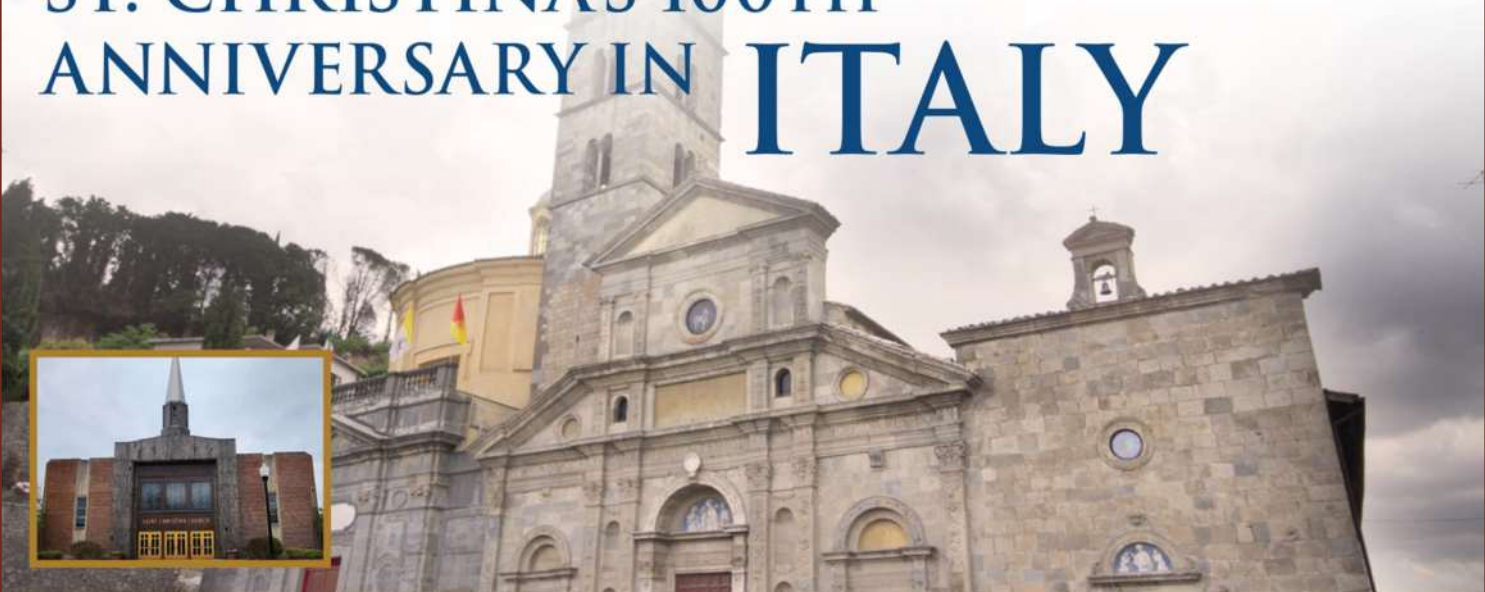

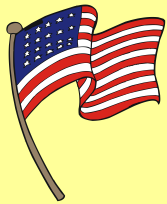
St. Christina Parish Domestic Violence Outreach

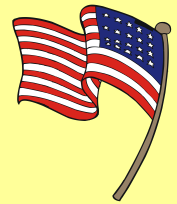

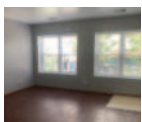
